#### Please note:

- There will be NO cranes hired by the club for launch or haul out this year, due to low water level.
- The seniority process normally used after March 31st, will now be used to assign slippage.
- You must inform the Harbour Master by June 12 if you request slippage. If you request slippage after that date, you will not be entitled to bump, regardless of seniority.

Everyone who applied for slippage by March 31, will be getting their points this year, whether you are able to put your boat in or not. The issue of a rebate is under review, but is premature until we are sure of the water levels. We will discuss the issue with members in the fall.


