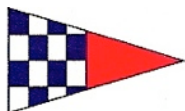

Go to: <http://nbyc.digimerge.net> You should get a pop up screen with some info to fill in. Int the top right quarter of screen, fill in: Port: 6100, user ID: ADMIN, Password: 1234, Click MODIFY. OK.

Then on next screen, top right quarter, click on ON button (small circle). This should connect and show images from the camera.
